

# Weekly Overview for Year 1



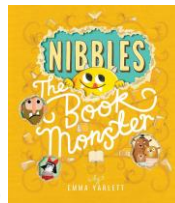
In the instance that your child is required to remain off school as a result of self-isolating, here is an overview of the learning taking place in class this week.
