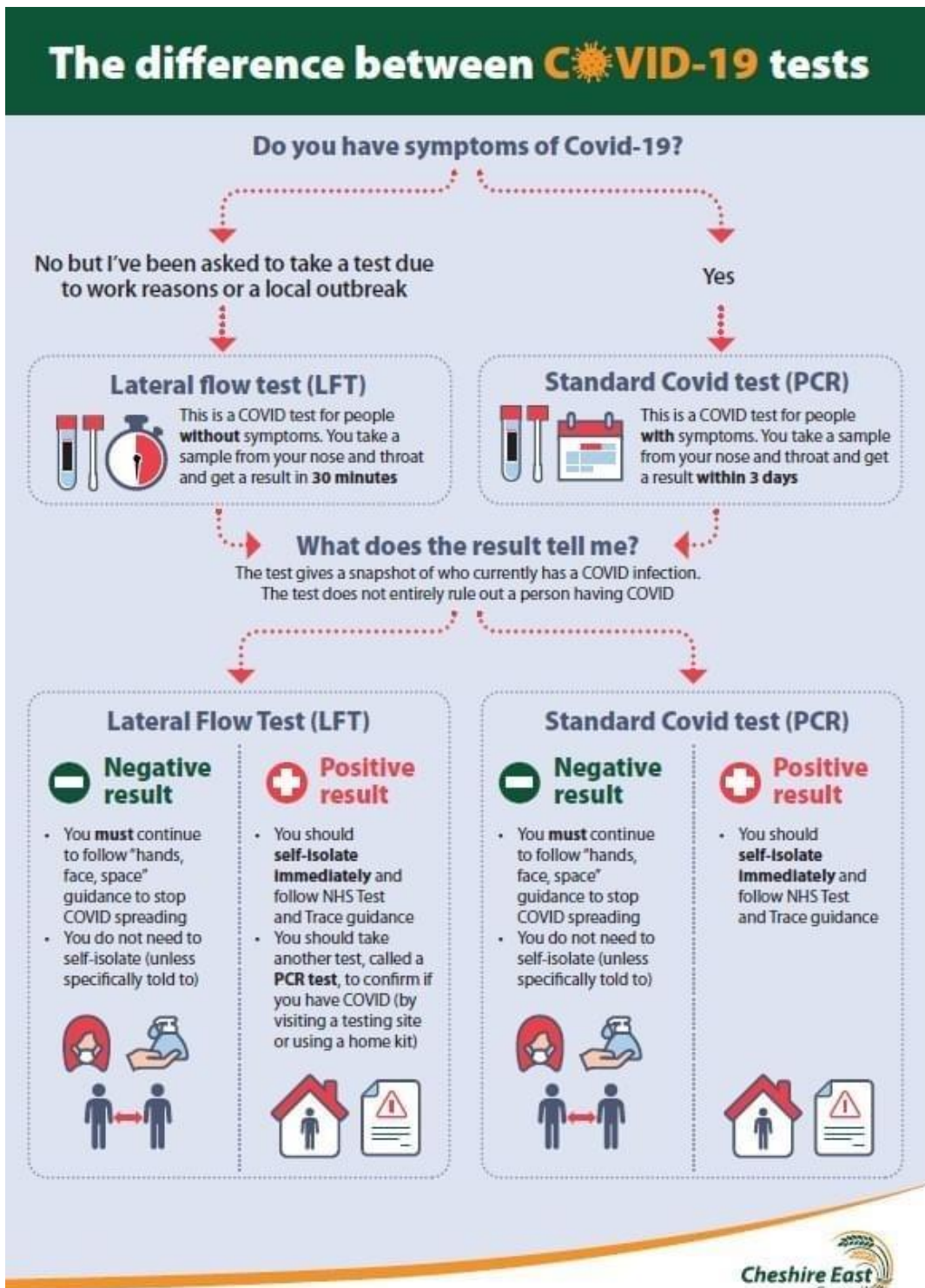

REPEATED INFORMATION

The information below has been shared before – you may have read it already, but we have kept it here as it is important.

Coronavirus

Your child must not come into school if they have the following symptoms: a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss or change in taste or smell. If your child has these symptoms they should book a test using www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/get-a-test-to-check-if-you-have-coronavirus/ or by calling 119. If your child tests positive, please contact school as soon as possible using this email address: covid19@wistaston.cheshire.sch.uk. Receiving a negative result from a lateral flow device test at home does not change this process.
