I hope you all managed to enjoy a good half-term, despite the weather.

We are now two days into a second national lockdown – this one is different because schools remain open to all children. We are delighted to be offering a safe and happy place for children to learn and we shall continue to do our best for the children throughout this period.

There are going to need to be some differences over the next few weeks:

- Apart from drop off and pick up, parents and carers should not come on to the school site at all
  without prior arrangement. For this to work, it is important that the children are brought to
  school on time. There have been a few occasions this week where children have been late and we
  ask for your support in reducing this.
- Parents should wear a face covering whenever they are on the school site. If you are exempt
  from wearing a face covering, we would be grateful if you let us know or wear the recognised
  Hidden Disabilities sunflower lanyard so that we know.
- When in communal areas like corridors or staffrooms, school staff will wear a face covering.
   (Note that these won't typically be worn in classrooms or when working with children unless this is close work or group work.)
- We need to reduce handling of reading records, so please let your child know if there is a
  message for us in the book, or mark the message with a Post-It note so that we don't need to go
  through books unexpectedly.
- Music lessons for Year Four will be led by Love Music Trust via an online link. We intend to run
  any individual peripatetic lessons this way but we are working out the logistics of how we can do
  this.

Again, I need to remind you that your child must not come to school if there are symptoms of coronavirus in the household (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss or change in taste or smell). Everyone in the household must isolate until that person receives a negative result. If the result is positive for a member of your household, please make us aware as soon as possible as this means that your child will need to be off school for 14 days. Once you have a negative result please let us know.

#### REPEATED INFORMATION

## Coronavirus

Your child should not come into school if they have the following symptoms: a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss or change in taste or smell.
